

### STIPRINKIME TAUTOS ATEITĮ. REMKIME LIETUVOS VAIKUSI

Suvažiavę iš visų išeivijos lietuvių pasaulio kampų į IX-tąją Išeivijos Lietuvių Tautinių Sokių Sventę džiaugiamės kartu savuoju prieaugliu, savos tautos gyvastingumu. Juk mūsų prieauglio stiprios lietuviškos dvasios išlaikymas užtikrina tautos kultūrinį išlikimą išeivijoje, atgimstančiai tautai taip reikalingą ateities paramos užnugarį.

Įvairiopais būdais tiesioginiai remiame atgimstančio krašto pastangas. Tačiau svarbu dalį paramos skirti ir Lietuvos savarankiškos ateities užgarantuotojams, tautos brangiausiam lobynui -- Lietuvos vaikams.

Lietuvos Vaikų Vilties komiteto užsibrėžtas tikslas yra sudaryti sąlygas invalidams Lietuvos vaikams atvažiuoti į JAV ir pasinaudoti Shriner's ligoninėse teikiama mediciniška (ortopedine, neurologine ir apdegimo) pagalba. Shriner's ligoninių specialistai daktarai atrenka vaikus, kuriems Lietuvoj nėra jokios vilties pilnutiniam, sveikam gyvenimui. Atvažiavę atrinkti vaikai nepastovi ant kojų, daugumas negalintįs ilgai ir sėdėti. Po operacijų, grįžta tėvynėn stiprūs, normalūs, sveiki.

Gydymas nieko nekainuoja. Bet vaiko ir vieno iš tėvų atvežimas, jų išlaikymas prieš ir po ligoninės bei kitos išlaidos siekia iki šešių tūkstančių dolerių kiekvienam vaikui.

Siuo metu Chicagoje yra devyni vaikai. Dar trys neužilgo atvyksta. Vieniems operacijos jau padarytos; jie sveiksta. Kiti tebelaukia eilės. Portlando ir Californijos ligoninėse priimti dar keturi vaikai. Prašymų yra daugybės. Negaluojančių vaikų vien Sauliuose esamoje sanitorijoje yra šimtai.

Kreipiamės į Jus prašydami pagalbos. Savo auka padėti Lietuvos invalidams vaikams.

Padėdami Lietuvos vaikams atsistoti tvirtai ant savų kojų užtikrinsime stiprius žingsnius Lietuvos savarankiškai ateičiai.

## STRENGTHEN A NATION'S FUTURE; HELP LITHUANIA'S CHILDREN

The IX Lithuanian Folk Dance Festival is a time to celebrate freedom; to rejoice in our youth—the pride and strength of Lithuanian heritage and spirit. It is only through our children that Lithuania's future.

There are various methods and means which we can choose to aid reawakening Lithuania. Few would disagree that a portion of this aid should be directly directed to Lithuania's most valuable asset -- Lithuania's children.

The major purpose of the Lithuanian Children's Hope committee is to assist disabled children for whom medical (orthopedic, neurological and burn) assistance cannot be obtained in Lithuania. Such costly medical care is made feasible by Shriner's hospitals throughout the United States.

These children, selected by Shriner's hospital specialists, arrive unable to walk or even sit for any length of time. Following intensive treatment, they return home standing tall, able to live a normal childhood, a productive adult life. All phases of medical care are provided at no expense by Shriner's hospitals. But, each child's and accompanying parent's transportation, living expenses prior to and after the hospital stay can reach up to \$6,000.

Nine children are already here in Chicago. Their treatment has begun. Another three have been accepted and will be arriving soon. The Shriner's hospitals in California and Portland have accepted four more children. These are just a few among so many hundreds of disabled children who, without our help, face a bleak and in some cases short life.

On behalf of Lithuania's children we appeal to you for assistance -- a donation. By helping Lithuania's children, we will be helping to strengthen Lithuania's future.
